Financial Update	Whitney reached out to fiscal agent in Meeker County to check our local tracking spreadsheet with actual funds. Actual in account vs. number on local tracking spreadsheet shows a difference of \$.50. This is assumed to be a miscalculation of carryover from years past on our part. Will run again at the end of 2020 to keep track. \$500 receipt paid to Olivia Hospital and Clinics for portion of feeding scale (from SEED money).

Sibley County has no updates to share. McLeod County staff not present.</p> <p>Moms Like You/WIC—USDA tied the waivers to the National Public Health Emergency. Once the national PH emergency has ended, WIC will resume in-person services within 30 days. Currently the national PH emergency goes through October but possibly will be extended. Meg (peer BF counselor) is currently attending CLS course! Job has been posted for peer breastfeeding counselor.</p> <p>NFP—Referrals are up and down. Some accept and then later decline.
